

8 Things to Remember When Selecting A Hazmat Packaging Shipper

1. Determine the product UN number required to ship your hazardous chemical. Check your MSDS sheet or reference BASCO Emergency Responds Book stock number BK100.
2. Define packing group number - Group 1, 2, 3. Not sure which group is correct? Check out our [Hazmat packaging guide](#) here.
3. Identify container or package size you will be using (pint, quart, gallon).
4. Is it a liquid or solid?
5. Determine what inner container is being used (can, bottle, etc.) Are you using your own inner container or do you need one from BASCO? If using your own inner container it must meet or exceed the test requirements of the package.
6. When shipping liquids via air with your own inner container – You'll need to have the inner container pressure tested to meet packaging requirements.
7. Department of Transportation (DOT) requires any person preparing the Hazmat Package must be UN certified to make sure they know how to properly prepare the package for shipping. This will help to avoid any penalties from DOT.
